### Year 10 Summer End of Year (Mock) Exams

I hope this letter finds you well.

I would like to take this opportunity to make you aware of the Year 10 series of end of year (mock) exams that are rapidly approaching.

From starting their GCSE courses in September 2020 and since returning in March, students have been working on a detailed program of new learning, catch-up and consolidation in all subject areas. This has been carefully planned to ensure students are in the strongest position to continue to move forward and complete their GCSE studies.

These exams are important as they will give teachers a very clear indication of how well your child is progressing at the moment. They will also indicate for teachers what subject content we should look at to support further learning.

From these exams, you will receive a data report based on your child's results and you will be invited to attend a Progress Consultation event in September where we will give you detailed feedback on your child's results.

You may find that your child has been invited by their teacher to intervention sessions in some subjects. If this is the case, you will be contacted directly via text by the teacher, to make you aware of when these sessions will be taking place.
